What is DairyPalooza?

- An all-day hands-on educational dairy program put on by a group of 4-H dairy advisors from across Ohio
- State-certified Quality Assurance provided as part of the program, using the Good Production Practices selected by Ohio 4-H to create interactive educational sessions on each point
- Sessions on pertinent and popular dairy topics, such as showmanship, fitting and grooming, animal handling, dairy cattle welfare, dairy nutrition, milk quality, breeding, and more
- Cloverbud programs run all day and adult sessions are held during Quality Assurance in the morning, to provide all attendees with chances to learn something new

When and where is DairyPalooza held?

DairyPalooza Northeast moves locations every two years to try and reach youth who are otherwise too far away to travel to the program.
